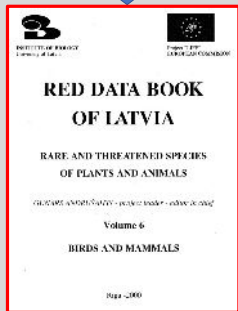
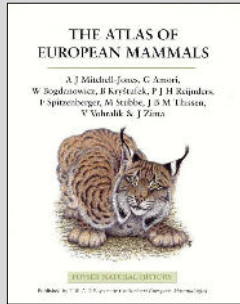

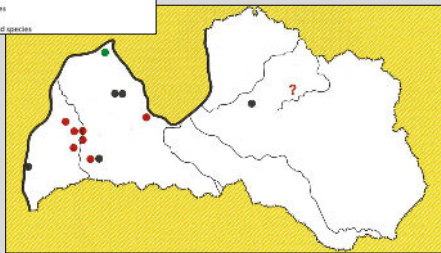
First dormice studies in Latvia as part of a Latvian and European mammal atlas project, started in 1991.

Dormice monitoring as part of the national biodiversity monitoring programme, started in 2016

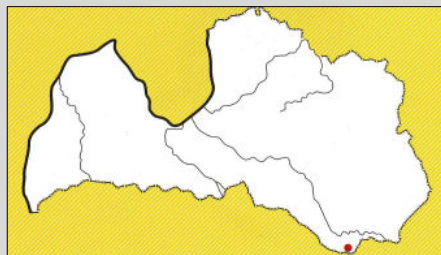
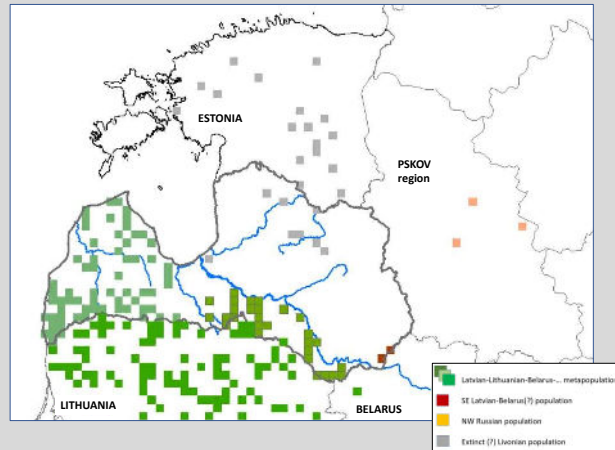
DORMICE - THEIR PRESENT STATUS IN LATVIA
