Invasive Alien Species - Biodiversity threats

Regulation 1143/2014 and implementing regulations

- 88 invasive alien species are strictly regulated
- 47 animal species of Union concern
- 41 plant species of Union concern

Hunting Law

Hunting regulations No.421, includes unrestricted wild game on non-native or invasive species.

All year round - American mink (*Mustela vison*), raccoon dog (*Nyctereutes procyonoides*), mouflon (*Ovis orientalis*), Sika deer (*Cervus nippon*), racoon (*Procyon lotor*), Coypu/nutria (*Myocastor coypus*), bobak marmot (*Marmota bobak*)



Fishery Law

Angling, crayfish catching and underwater hunting regulations (No.800), includes *Orconectes limosus* spiny-cheek crayfish and *Pacifastacus leniusculus* Signal crayfish catching.



Amendments in **Law on the Conservation of Species and Biotopes**. Adopted: 03.10.2024.

- institutions and functions in charge of IAS: Nature
 Conservation Agency, State Plant Protection Service, Latvian
 Institute of Aquatic Ecology, Food and Veterinary Service
 (Custom), State Forest Service, Latvian Environment Geology
 and Meteorology Center
- defines restrictions EU list, National list, general principles of IAS management
- defines administrative offences and penalties, administrative offence proceedings – involves State police, Municipal police, Municipal environmental control



Amendments in **Law on the Conservation of Species and Biotopes**. Adopted: 03.10.2024.

- Landowner is responsible for all invasive species management measures to prevent its further spread.
 Previously – only plant species, specifically Hogweed.
- Municipalities have the option to issue binding regulations on the National list.



Invasive Alien Species. Competent authorities:

Amendments in Law on the Conservation of Species and Biotopes. Adopted: 03.10.2024.

- 1) Nature Conservation Agency coordinating authority
- 2) State Plant Protection Service invasive plant species of Union concern. Monitoring
- 3) Latvian Institute of Aquatic Ecology all marineand coastal species. Monitoring
- **4) Food and Veterinary Service (Custom)** all species on border (border crossing points with veterinary or phytosanitary control)
- 5) State Forest Service game animals. Management
- 6) Latvian Environment Geology and Meteorology Center freshwater plant species. Monitoring



Invasive Alien Species. Legislation Latvia. Cabinet Regulation

Draft Cabinet Regulation for the «Prevention and Management of the introduction and spread of invasive species». The regulation is currently in the process of interministerial coordination. Ends 29.04.2025.

- Permits;
- Risk assessment;
- Monitoring and control;
- Management measures




